Planning DM/0384/23/FUL Station Road, Salon application

Cllr Harness advised that this application is going to planning committee, re the proposed change of plans for salon on Station Ave. In which the plans show this will have a flat above and neighbours to this site were very concerned that this will be visible from their garden. This seems to have been causing detrimental stress on the homeowners and detailed many objections. Residents have an issue with the revised version that has been presented. It was also discussed that car parking not adequate for the salon and the 2-bed flat.
