

SOCIAL MEDIA/FACEBOOK POLICY

Introduction and Purpose

New Waltham Parish Council recognises that digital and social media provides local government with an additional means by which it can communicate and engage with the local electorate. The use of the word "we" and "our" in this policy should be taken to mean New Waltham Parish

Council.

We will continue to use a variety of traditional communication means to ensure that the residents of our parish are kept informed of parish council business and are able to ask questions of the Council by means of the provision of a website; newsletters; notice-boards; corresponding by letter and email; telephone conversations; face to face meetings by appointment; and general public access to the council during set office opening times. This policy describes how we will use Facebook as an additional means of providing information for the residents of our parish.

The purpose of our Facebook page will be to provide timely information and updates regarding activities and opportunities within our parish and to promote constructive comments & suggestions from residents and local organisations.

Control

New Waltham Parish Council's Facebook page will be administered and moderated by the Clerk and Chair of the Council.

Our Facebook page is not monitored on an ongoing basis and no obligation is accepted to do so. It should not be assumed that we can automatically respond to any comment or question posted, instead those wishing to contact the Council or ask a question of us are referred to the council's postal address; its email address and its telephone number as the primary and most effective means to contact us. Our office is also open to the public via phone and email at the following times: 9.30am – 2pm.

All information or opinions posted by us will represent the official view or policy of New Waltham Parish Council and not that of any individual councillor or employee.

We will set our privacy settings to "only friends".

By choosing to comment and/or utilise New Waltham Parish Council's Facebook page, users are deemed to have agreed to this policy.

Posting of information and comments

When posting information and comments, this Council promises that we will meet the following criteria:

be civil, tasteful and relevant;

not contain content that is unlawful, libellous, harassing, defamatory, abusive, threatening, harmful, obscene, profane, sexually oriented or racially offensive;

not contain content copied from elsewhere, for which we do not own the copyright or have permission to re-produce;

not contain any personal information, other than necessary basic contact details; represent the view or policy of this Council;

engage in issues of a party political nature.

In order to ensure that all discussion on our Facebook page is productive, respectful,

energized and consistent with matters relating to this Council and the community we serve, the following guidelines must be observed:

share freely and be generous, but be aware of copyright laws;

be accurate and give credit where credit is due;

stay on topic;

expressing differing opinions lies at the heart of our democracy but using Facebook for the purpose of making personal attacks will not be permitted;

be considerate and respectful of others;

vulgarity, threats or abuse of language will not be tolerated;

We reserve the right to remove comments or content, which in our opinion is:

obscene, sexist, racist or discriminatory;

threatening;

potentially libellous;

material in violation of any laws;

private, personal information published without consent;

information or links unrelated to the Council or the parish;

commercial promotions, advertising or spam
